## What to do...

You need a partner to play with!

1. Write a 2 or 3 syllable word. (Compound words are particularly good!).
2. Your partner must write a new word starting with the syllable or part that is at the end of your word.
3. Then you write a word that starts with the last part of their word.
4. Keep going like this until you have produced a long 'chain' of connected words!
5. Keep trying. How long is your longest word-chain?
