

Woodley CofE School children have an excellent reputation for looking smart in their uniform. We are proud of our children and hope that you will help us maintain this high standard as it is important that your child is dressed appropriately and smartly at all times.

Please see our school uniform check list at the back of this policy.

PE kit should be worn into school on designated PE days. Children remain in their PE kit all day and do not need to bring school uniform to change into. Children should wear their school jumper or cardigan and bring their additional warmer layer for outside PE. Shorts should be worn under tracksuit bottoms so that bottoms can be removed if PE is indoors and the children do not overheat.

Jewellery should not be worn in school. If a child has pierced ears, plain gold or silver studs only should be worn. For safety, these have to be removed during PE. If your child wears jewellery for religious reasons that cannot be removed, please make your child's class teacher aware. If children are unable to remove their earrings without adult help, please do not send them into school with earrings on PE days. If the earrings cannot be removed for up to six weeks after piercing, please provide protective tape to be applied for PE lessons.

Extreme hairstyles are not acceptable in school and only natural colours are suitable for the children. Please support us in this by not allowing your child to attend school with inappropriate hairstyles and colours. Hair accessories; slides, scrunches and bands are to be red, black, grey or white and long hair must be tied back at all times. All make-up, including nail varnish should not be worn to school. Temporary tattoos are also unacceptable.

It is important that ALL of your children's belongings are clearly named. Each term we collect an enormous quantity of un-named items, many of which are almost new.

All types of shirt are to be tucked in at all times. In the event of hot weather, the Head Teacher may make the decision, on a day to day basis, to allow the children to leave their shirts untucked.

If you have any questions or concerns about items of clothing, please discuss with the school office or make an appointment to see the Head Teacher.

Skirt	Grey or black
Pinafore dress	Grey or black
Shorts	Grey or black
Trousers	Grey or black
Summer dress	Red and white checked
Cardigan	Red
Jumper	Red
Socks	Grey, black or white
Tights	Red or grey
Polo shirts	Red or white
Shirts	White
PE shorts	Red or black
PE shirt	White
Tracksuit bottoms	Black or grey (for extra warmth in the colder months)
Sweatshirt	Black or grey (for health and safety reasons please do not provide a hoodie)
School shoes/trainers	Black (which provide a good grip and fasten securely. Black trainers can be provided in place of school shoes if preferred)
