



Dear Parents,

Sibling Club. Yesterday we sent home, via ParentMail, an important letter regarding Sibling Club. Please make sure you book your child/ren in using the link, provided within yesterday's letter, by Wednesday 7th October. After the 7th of October, if you need to use this provision contact the school office. For early collections, please continue to collect your children from their usual points. As your child will be dismissed by a different member of staff, please let them know who you are collecting.

Flu vaccinations. Flu vaccinations are planned to take place at school on 14th December 2020 for all year groups. We will be in touch after half term with further information. Parental permission is sought before the vaccinations take place. The date is allocated to us by the school nursing team and we have no influence over this. If your child has underlying medical needs and you feel your child would benefit from receiving the vaccination earlier please contact your doctor's surgery.

Coats. As we continue into the Autumn Term and the weather starts to become colder, we will still need to keep up good COVID practice and keep rooms as well ventilated as possible. Please ensure your child has a jumper and a coat in school should they feel the need to wrap up a little warmer. Children continue to go outside to play in all weathers so adequate outdoor clothing is necessary.

PE Year 1-6. PE lessons will continue to be outside through most weathers, so please ensure your child has a warm layer to put over their PE kit. Tracksuit bottoms and a sweatshirt are ideal. Please ensure any clothing that comes into school is clearly named with your child's forename and surname.

Authorisation. If someone other than the two people you have given us authority for is collecting your child/ren from school, please telephone the school office. Children will not be released unless we have your authorisation.

Uniform. We are aware many of you are waiting on uniform orders made either at the end of the Summer Term or this term. Due to many factors experienced worldwide with lockdowns and factory shutdowns, this has resulted in delayed shipments and deliveries. We will send home uniform with your child as soon as the stock arrives. Thank you for your patience at this time.

Uniform Passes. If you have a problem with uniform and you need your child to wear an item of clothing that is not usually permitted, i.e. trainers, please email admin@wcofe.com so that a uniform pass can be issued. Each uniform pass issued will be given an end date and your child will then be expected to be back in the correct uniform at the date stated.


