Leadership and Management

- To ensure that school development is effectively monitored and evaluated by all leaders.
- To coach and mentor new senior leaders so they effectively hold staff to account.
- To raise parental expectation and aspirations for their children across the curriculum at all key stages.

Quality of Teaching, Learning and Assessment

- To continue to develop high quality practice across all phases to ensure all teaching is good or better.
- To continue to develop a whole school strategy to improve the teaching of reading with a particular focus on comprehension.
- To develop a greater understanding of differentiation so that work is appropriate for all groups of children.(especially children entitled to the Pupil Premium Grant and those with Special Educational Needs)

Personal Development, Behaviour and Safety

- To implement new Child Protection and Safeguarding legislation and review practice accordingly.
- To review systems and procedures for taking children off-site and implement changes accordingly.
- To continually monitor the attendance of all children to decrease persistent absence.

Outcomes For Pupils

- To raise attainment at the end of FS2, KS1 and KS2 so that it is at least in line with the national average and for 85% of children to make the expected progress in reading, writing and maths.
- To continue to closely track “at risk pupils” who are in danger of not meeting expected standards.

## School Improvement Plan

### Early Years Provision

- To develop more opportunities for writing in EYFS and transition into Year 1 to improve standards.
- To ensure that all learning opportunities are well-planned and linked directly to meet the needs of the children.
