Primary Sports Funding 2017-18

For the past 4 years, the government have been providing additional funding of £160 million per annum to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding is ring-fenced and therefore can only be spent on provision of PE and sport in schools. At Woodley CE Primary School an action plan has been developed to ensure that children have every opportunity to participate in a range of sports and receive high quality teaching. We aim to improve PE provision and utilise the funding to increase participation in physical activity, raise achievement and enjoyment for all pupils.

Our priorities mean that the funding of £18,670 for 2017-2018 will be used:

Teaching and Learning

- To increase the confidence, knowledge and skills of PE lead in teaching PE and Sport
- To give children, across all Key Stages, exposure to a range of sports.
- To develop a manageable assessment system
- To complete an audit of the school's provision and consider application PE Mark

Pupil Achievement and progress

- To recognise and reward excellent pupil participation in sport
- To ensure assessment system monitors progress effectively.

Competitive opportunities

• To use funding available to ensure gifted pupils are given exciting opportunities to compete representing the school

Whole School Advocacy and Impact

• To effectively raise the profile of Physical Education & Sport across the whole school.

Enrichment Opportunities

- To provide stimulating and exciting extra-curricular sporting clubs throughout the academic year.
- To monitor, evaluate and promote extra-curricular activities

Inclusion, Engagement and School Culture

- To promote a healthy and active lifestyle for all pupils.
- Increase the opportunities for our SEND children to participate fully in PE lessons.
