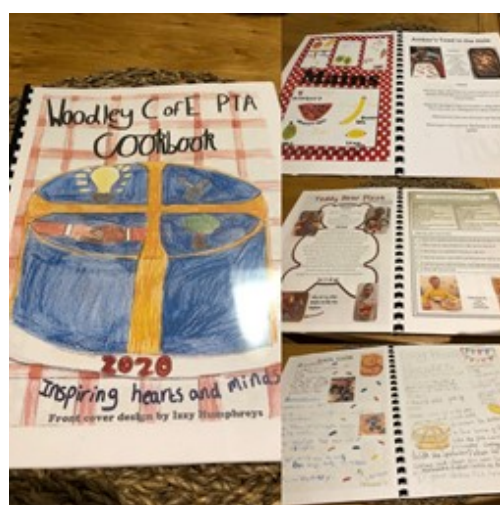
PTA Cook Books
