Leadership and Management

- To develop a clear strategy to support Pupil Premium children that will lead to greater progress
- To ensure that all school policies are reviewed, up to date and are effectively used in school by all stakeholders.
- To improve communication with parents to ensure they are effective partners in their children's learning
- To review the leadership structure of the school to ensure the development of distributive leadership
- To review the use of space within the school and formulate a plan for improvement.
- To improve the outdoor facilities of the school so they can be used effectively to support learning.
- To establish and support a new governing body to challenge and support school leaders.

Quality of Teaching, Learning and Assessment

- To develop a whole school Teaching and Learning Policy to link all elements of good practice within the school.
- To evaluate provision for all groups of children so that they all make good or better progress from their starting points.
- To review marking and feedback within the school to ensure that it promotes effective learning.
- To evaluate the school curriculum and make changes to take account of recent developments
- To establish a consistent strategy for the teaching of writing and maths to improve the standard of teaching and learning
- To improve the attainment and progress of reading in KS2 especially with regard to the comprehension of texts.
- To eradicate unsatisfactory teaching and ensure that all teaching is at least good.

Personal, Development, Behaviour and Safety

 To review Child Protection and Safeguarding procedures to ensure whole school consistency.

School Improvement Plan Overview

- To review BRIGHT learning and ensure that it is consistently in place across the school.
- To continually review the schools core Christian values and embed them into all we do.

Outcomes For Pupils

- To improve systems and provision within SEN so that any underachievement is addressed
- To establish an effective system for pupil progress meetings to address any underachievement and to ensure that at least 85% of pupils make expected progress.
- To develop an analysis of cohort achievement to deliver required support to ensure that school is in line with national averages for reading, writing and maths.

Early Years Provision

 To evaluate provision at FS2 to ensure that all children make good progress from their starting points.
