New Classes (September 2020)

As we plan to group the children across year groups for English and Maths in the mornings, this has allowed us to ensure that all classes are of a mixed ability. Therefore, mixed age classes and straight year group classes are grouped with no academic ability.

Classes have therefore now been selected by staff using the following criteria:

- Friendships
- SEN Needs and their supporting staff members

Transition

As previously shared with you, transition visits are as follows:

Friday 3rd July - **Year 3 and 4** - Lower Key Stage Two (LKS2) - current Year 2 and Year 3

Friday 10th July - **Year 1 and 2** - Key Stage One (KS1) - current Year FS2 and Year 1

Friday 17th July - **Year 5 and 6** - Upper Key Stage Two (UKS2) - current Year 4 and 5

You will receive a letter approximately a week before your transition visit informing you of your child's new teacher and arrangements for the transition visit. Please note that the children will be coming at staggered times into groups of approximately ten children. The groups are being organised in alphabetical order.
