Latest Government Announcement

As you are now aware, the Government has asked schools to open from 1st June for children in Foundation, Y1 and Y6. The Government has provided information about this for parents ([Click here](#)).

Can we ask that if you haven't already done so, please can remind parents with children in Foundation, Y1 and Y6 to complete the survey sent out on Wednesday 13th May by 9am Monday 18th May. If you do not complete the survey to register your interest your child will not be able to attend school from 1st June

Key Worker School will continue as usual but children may also be placed into small groups also known as bubbles.

We understand that there is a lot of anxiety for parents when deciding if it is appropriate for their child to return to school. As usual, we will continue to keep you informed of new information as it comes to light. We currently do not have any more guidance other than that shared by the Government this week.
