Dear Parents/Carers,

### COVID-19 Update

At Woodley C of E Primary School, we are doing all we can to keep the children and staff safe from COVID-19 as much as is reasonably practicable, to ensure we avoid any bubble closures.

So, to remind you of our current requirements:-

- If any members of your household display symptoms of COVID-19, they must isolate and arrange a test.
- Notify the school immediately.
- **Do not send your child to school** – even if they are not displaying symptoms – it is a risk to other children, adults and the continuity of the school if a child attends school with a member of their household displaying symptoms.
- If the result is positive, then the person should isolate for 10 days from when symptoms appeared.
- You must notify the school when a positive result is known and affects a child that attends our school. We will ask for sight of the test result.
- All other household members – including your child - must isolate from the point of symptoms of COVID being noticed - for 14 days.
- We will ask for confirmation that your child is well before they can return to school.
- If the test result is negative, we will ask for sight of the result and your child can return to school.

We continue to monitor guidance from central Government. Our hope is that we can continue for as long as possible with minimum disruption to the education of the children.
