

Recycling...

Thank you for the ongoing support with our recycling schemes. Not only does this raise money for the school, but our last efforts stopped over 3000 crisp packets going into landfill. We are also teaching our children how we can reduce waste and looking after our environment, so keep them involved. We hope to send a parcel after the next collection for the Pladis Scheme, so please continue to collect cake bar, biscuit and cracker wrappers as well as crisp packets. We now have an additional scheme in the form of Pringles so please save your tubes, the foil top and plastic lids (no supermarket alternatives). Looking forward we are hoping to have a recycling station to be placed at the school. In the meantime, there will be a crate by the PTA box for you to drop off your waste which we will send off once we have a large amount. As we learn more about the ways in which we collect and send the waste away for each scheme, please help us with the following

WALKERS SCHEME

□ Always check your waste against the Recycling Scheme Accepted Waste Poster attached (NO NUTS/POPCORN/MEAT SNACKS). This hugely affects the weight and if a box is underweight because of unaccepted waste then we do not receive any money for that whole box!

PLADIS SCHEME

□ Again, please check the Recycling Scheme Accepted Waste Poster for the scheme as things like clear packaging (flapjacks, brownies) super noodles and nut packets are not part of the programme.

Please start to create eco bricks out of your crisp packets, this makes it so much easier for packing them for transport. Take 20 crisp packets, fold 19 in half and place inside the 20th packet, voila you've made an eco-brick! This supports us in packing as much into the box as possible.

There are a number of schemes that we are on the waiting list for and hopefully we can bring these to you and the school in the near future. In the meantime thank you for your ongoing support.
